

***Guidelines for Online Character Teaching Program  
for Program Coordinators/Teachers/Parents  
Video Program Guidelines***

- 1. Gather a group of persons who have interest in teaching character qualities to their own children or who are working in a school or church Sunday School program with children.***
  
- 2. Explain the video teaching program to them and share your schedule for the video training showings. Encourage the participants to attend all video teaching sessions.***
  
- 3. After each video showing give time for discussions in small groups of 5 or less people. Each video teaching is 10 -15 minutes in length.  
Answer the following questions:  
1. What did I learn in this session?  
2. How will I apply what I have learned to my life and my teaching?***
  
- 4. Make sure to inform all who attend the video sessions that they will receive access to free character lesson materials, workbooks for children, and character songs through the website after they have completed the course.  
  
They are to understand that they will be responsible for the downloading and printing cost of the lesson materials & any costs related to duplication of songs or videos.***
  
- 5. When the participants have completed the training course, they are permitted to teach the character lesson materials and to teach this course to others. The training course, the lesson materials, workbooks, and songs are not to be sold for financial gain.***

- 6. Those who attend all the character training sessions will receive a completion certificate from the program coordinator which gives them qualification and permission to train others.***
- 7. It is suggested that the training sessions of this course be offered over a several week period, which will allow the participates times of reflection on the materials content and to give application to their own lives.***

### ***Student's Character Program***

- 1. Teachers are encouraged that after they have taught the lesson to a large group of students, the class is to be divided into small discussion groups of 2 – 4 students. These discussion groups help children to apply the principles of character to their lives.***
- 2. This arrangement will allow the students to discuss and apply the principles of the lessons to their lives. It is suggested to have one older child to guide younger children in the discussion time.***
